

AWARFNESS

PRINCIPLES

To ensure that everyone feels comfortable and has a good time at our events, it is the goal of the Fachschaft Agrarwissenschaften (Agricultural Sciences Student Council) to make every situation as safe as possible and to stand together against any form of discrimination* and abusive behavior.

The following guidelines are therefore binding to all participants, volunteers and helpers at our events:

- Only "yes" means yes. Respect your own boundaries and those of your counterpart and make sure you do not cross them!
- No tolerance for violence. Violations will result in immediate exclusion from the event. This applies to both threatened, verbal and/or physical violence.
- Listen to those affected. The definition of whether and how boundary violation has occurred lies solely with the person affected.
- Look out for each other. Check left and right from time to time. If someone near you is not feeling well, get help or help them yourself. If you feel that someone might be in trouble, ask them just to be on the safe side it's better to ask one too often than once too little. Respect the decision also if your help is declined.
- Respect identities. This includes making a recognizable effort to use desired names, pronouns, and dorms of address, as well as not questioning the identities of others or having to justify your own.
- **Consensus.** Everyone defines their own boundaries different. The only was to reliably find out what these are is to ask explicitly for consent. Do not pressure or persuade anyone.
- Communicate sensitively. Language can be discriminatory or border-crossing: be mindful of how you communicate.

Important: Start planning a year in advance!

BAföG

BAföG is a form of educational support under the Federal Training Assistance Act, half of which is granted as a loan and half as a grant (at least for the time being).

Whether it is granted and how much depends mainly on the parents' income.

Important: It is granted at the earliest from the month in which training begins and is paid at the earliest from the month in which the application is submitted.

You can seek advice from the AStA Social Affairs Department or directly from the Office for Educational Assistance.

Libraries

There are several libraries in Bonn, one of which you will automatically pass on your way to the canteen:

Departmental Library for Medicine, Natural Sciences and Agriculture (MNL): Friedrich Hirzebruch-Allee 4, 53115 Bonn.

Here you will find specialist literature for our field and a quiet place that helps you concentrate.

Opening hours: daily from 8 a.m. to midnight.

Otherwise, there is also:

University and State Library (ULB) at Adenauerallee 39-41.

Student library in the main building, Regina Pacis Weg 1, here there are no specialist books, but newspapers, novels and similar.

c.t.

Means cum tempore and means that all events that are announced on the hour start a quarter of an hour later (academic quarter). In plain language: sleep a quarter of an hour longer in the morning...

Dies Academicus

Always takes place on a Wednesday during the lecture period. The regular events are cancelled on this day, which is entirely dedicated to the Studium Universale.

Fachschaft

That's us, agricultural students from different semesters.

The student council rooms are open during the semester on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.

If you have any questions, problems, etc. — just drop by.

The meetings of the student council, or rather the student council board and the student council representatives, are always held on Mondays at 8 p.m. during the semester. If you are interested or simply curious, you are welcome to drop by (only in German).

Trade journals

In addition to books and lecture notes, there are a number of trade journals available, and it certainly can't hurt to keep up to date with current topics in agriculture.

Many of these journals are available at the student council (just ask) or articles are available online — so a subscription is not absolutely necessary. If you do want to take out a subscription, it is advisable to look for student rates.

Exams

Start: End of semester

You must register for exams at Basis within a certain period of time (see the page in the booklet 'Deadlines & Dates' &

the Examination Office website).

Matriculation

List of students enrolled at the university. At the start of their studies, all students receive their matriculation number, which remains valid until they leave the university.

Canteen

There are three canteens in Bonn — one at each of the main locations. Conveniently located and with a varied selection.

The meal plans for the next two weeks can be viewed on the Student Services website and in the University of Bonn app.

Re-registering

At the end of a semester, you do not automatically remain a student, but must re-register each time (otherwise you will usually be de-registered). To do so, transfer the social contribution — see Student Services.

Lecture notes / lecture materials

These are materials for lectures that are either published by the respective lecturers or written by students. Most lecturers also make their lecture notes available on eCampus.

s.t.

This stands for sine tempore and means that these events start punctually at the advertised time, i.e. without academic quarter.

Study counselling

The written information and group events are an important part of study counselling.

This is so that students can complete their "tasks" such as admission, internships, studies and theses without personal counselling.

During the semester, you will have several information events on current topics and on the Bachelor's programme in general.

WLAN / eduroam

In order to use the Wi-Fi at the university and to access the university network from home using VPN, you will need to install various apps on your devices (mobile phone, tablet, laptop). 
